- Send water bottle and snack (approved snack list- on website under important downloads)







THE BASICS-MORNING ARRIVAL

- Beginning Thursday, August 15 (2nd day)- arrival
 7:30-7:50 a.m. (please wait for faculty to arrive at 7:30 a.m.)
- Every Wednesday- arrival from 8:30-8:50 a.m.
- Pull all the way up–faculty members are there to helpsidewalk side only
- Class begins at 7:50 a.m. (Wednesdays- 8:50 a.m.)
- After 7:50 a.m. (Wednesdays-8:50 a.m.)- park and check your child in at the Lower School office
- Perimeter Gates are locked at all times
 – visitors must use call box at gate and check in with receptionist in Lower School Office

THE BASICS-AFTERNOON DISMISSAL

- Dismissal for LS carriders not waiting for MS and US siblings is 2:55-3:10 p.m.
- Please pull all the way to the front of the carpool loop
- After 3:10 p.m. LS car riders will go to extended day and parents will need to follow ext. day procedures for pickup
- If also picking up MS and US children-please wait until 3:10 p.m. to get in the carpool line
- If students have choir on Tues/Thurs–3:20 p.m.
- If picking up early use School Pass and park and come into the LS office by 2:30 p.m. to sign student out
